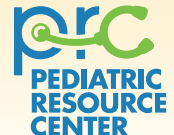
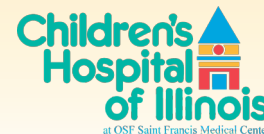

Despite the widespread acceptance of abusive head trauma in the medical community for decades now, there remain a small minority of individuals who question the legitimacy of the diagnosis with resultant potentially devastating medical and legal consequences. This presentation will review some of the high-quality medical literature on abusive head trauma and address the tactics and motivations of those who may oppose its validity.
