Professor of Pediatrics
Chief, Division of Endocrinology
University of Florida College of Medicine

Dr. Janet Silverstein will be giving us her thoughts on advances in diabetes management, including information about the closed-loop insulin pump (also called the “bionic pancreas”), advances and challenges in the generation and transplantation of insulin-producing pancreatic islet cells, and current research aimed at prevention of type 1 diabetes.
