SYMPOSIUM PURPOSE

The purpose of this hands on and lecture seminar is to educate the general OB practitioner and OB sonographer on proper anatomical assessment of the fetal heart to then improve the sensitivity of screening the fetal sonograms.

Program Objectives:

1. Identify basic fetal cardiac anatomy including cardiac circumference, situs, LV and RV diameter from the 4 chamber view; outflow tracts and pulmonary and aortic annular dimensions.
2. Apply fetal cardiac dimensions to published z-values to identify patients with values outside published norms.
3. Improve on a basic understanding of congenital heart disease and intracardiac and extracardiac connections/anatomy.
